The Plugin(s)

- **Crossref and PKP first co-developed a plugin for Crossref members *in 2009!***
- **Since then:**
 - **Reference linking**
 - **New deposit API**
 - **Funding**

Sponsorship (2014)

- 37 publishers/organizations/clients
- 17 w/waived deposit fees
- 14805 DOIs *so far!*
